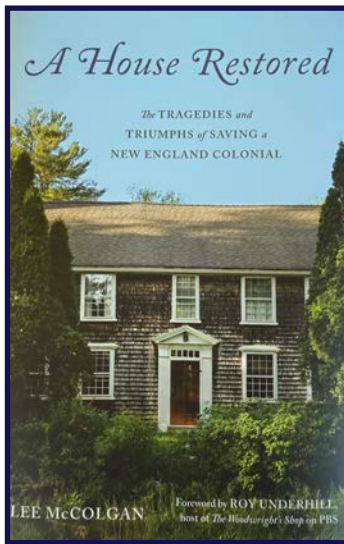

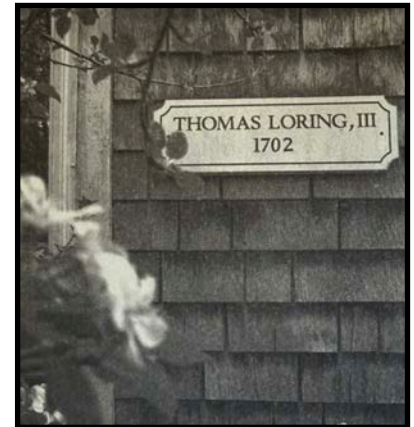

This Year's Featured Presentation by Lee McColgan

Join us in welcoming Lee McColgan, author of *A HOUSE RESTORED, The TRAGEDIES and TRIUMPHS of SAVING a NEW ENGLAND COLONIAL*.



"Trading the corporate ladder for a stepladder," Lee started as a neophyte, with thoughts of "how hard can it be?" to becoming a "jack of all trades." The historic preservation muse took over in a matter of months leaving investment banking in the dust.



Lee will regale you with stories of the challenges he faced in restoring an 18th century house--the Thomas Loring III House, built in 1702. Undoubtedly, it was a witness site to the Revolution as it was extant during this era and has survived to the present day. What happened in Pembroke, Massachusetts during the Revolution? Details on that remain to be discovered.
